

The Laryngology Fellowship
Training Program provides
fellows with advance tuition in
the field of Laryngology. The
education program combines
core basic knowledge of
Laryngology and
communication sciences in
conjunction with clinical aspects
of diagnosis and medical and
surgical management of
diseases of Larynx.

OVERVIEW

"The programme is designed to offer an intensive one-year training in laryngology at an advance level to enable the practitioner to pursue a career in laryngology. The programme comprises of supervised training in four main areas:

- Diagnostic (Voice clinic, Swallowing clinic and Singers' Clinic)
- Speech and voice therapy,
- Surgical procedures and
- Research & Education

Enrolment Fee- INR 147500 Fellows would be paid monthly Stipend.

Application begins with a statement of interest to the programme director. Following initial screening, suitable applicants will be invited to apply.

A CV and two letters supporting the application should be submitted. The decision will be communicated to the applicant and the applicant will have to appear for an interview online. The fellowship programme commences in the month of July every year

COMPLETION CRITERIA

End of the term assessment evaluation is an integral part of the Fellowship Training. Assessment is scheduled at the end of fellowship training program. Evaluation process will also include fellows' Log Book, dissertation, publication and research work during the period of attachment and their participation in academic activities.

This fellowship program envisages that Fellows should leave this program with the confidence and skill to practice laryngology as a career at the highest level.
